

HOW TO CALCULATE GPA

GPA = Quality points divided by credits

In a 1 credit class:

■ A = 4	quality points	Honors +.5 (A=4.5)	AP courses +1 (A=5)
■ B = 3	“ “	“ (B=3.5)	“ (B=4)
■ C = 2	“ “	“ (C=2.5)	“ (C=3)
■ D = 1	“ “	(D=1)	(D=1)
■ F = 0	“ “		

Example :

Honors English :	Grade A = 4.5 quality points for	1 credit
9 th Grade Science:	Grade B = 3 quality points for	1 credit
Algebra I:	Grade B = 3 quality points for	1 credit
U.S. History:	Grade B = 3 quality point for	1 credit
Spanish I:	Grade D = 1 quality point for	1 credit
Band:	Grade A = 4 quality points for	1 credit
Health:	Grade B = 1.5 quality points for	.5 credit
<u>Phys. Ed.:</u>	<u>Grade A = 1 quality point for</u>	<u>.25 credit</u>

21 divided by 6.75 = **3.11 GPA**

Note: Cumulative GPA is based only on final course grades
