Graduation Requirements *NEW FOR THE CLASS OF 2023*

Ohio's new graduation requirements consist of three key components:

1. Course Completion – Students will satisfy Ohio's curriculum requirements and any additional local requirements (see previous slide)

2. Competency

Demonstration – Students will demonstrate competency in the foundational areas of English Language Arts and Mathematics (or alternative demonstrations)

3. Readiness Demonstration – Students well demonstrate readiness for post-high school paths by earning two readiness seals.

Online Health

- Independent study, working through online modules
- Time is provided in "Health/Study" Period
- Must achieve 70% to move on
- After 3 attempts, students must request a reset to try again
- Multiple presentations face-to-face (including AED/CPR and Opiate)



Auburn Career Center (ACC)

Career/Tech Prep Program REQUIREMENTS:

- ✓ All 9th & 10th grade core classes completed
- ✓ Junior class standing (at least 10 credits completed)
- 2.0 GPA minimum for Career/Tech Prep programs
- ✓ Good attendance/tardiness record
- ✓ Good counselor recommendation


*Beginning with the Class of 2020 and beyond, KHS will no longer report Class Rank.


