- 7 credits Electives
 - 22 credits total
- 16 Service Hours

Graduation Requirements

NEW FOR THE CLASS OF 2023

Ohio's new graduation requirements consist of three key components:

1. **Course Completion** – Students will satisfy Ohio's curriculum requirements and any additional local requirements (see previous slide)
2. **Competency Demonstration**– Students will demonstrate competency in the foundational areas of English Language Arts and Mathematics (or alternative demonstrations)
3. **Readiness Demonstration** – Students will demonstrate readiness for post-high school paths by earning two readiness seals.

Online Health

- ▶ Independent study, working through online modules
- ▶ Time is provided in “Health/Study” Period
- ▶ Must achieve 70% to move on
- ▶ After 3 attempts, students must request a reset to try again
- ▶ Multiple presentations face-to-face (including AED/CPR and Opiate)



Auburn Career Center (ACC)

Career/Tech Prep Program REQUIREMENTS:

- ✓ All 9th & 10th grade core classes completed
- ✓ Junior class standing (at least 10 credits completed)
- ✓ 2.0 GPA minimum for Career/Tech Prep programs
- ✓ Good attendance/tardiness record
- ✓ Good counselor recommendation
