Tutoring Update

- We have spoken to other districts to see what their policies are in regards to tutoring S's.
- We reached out to Riverside, Grand Valley, Chardon, Mentor, West G, W-E, Kenston & Wickliffe through this process we have added approximately 36 more teachers to our sub/tutor list. We have a list at KLS for any parent(s) looking for a potential tutor for their student(s).

Snow Day (School Cancellation) Provisions

• Discussed as to whether a standard be set for Snow Day provisions to happen on Day 1 of first Snow Day. Currently on-line Snow Day packets not required until 6th Snow Day.

- We are exploring ways to better maximize lost instructional time during Calamity days for both students and teachers.
- We currently have 178 school days scheduled for year.
- We currently do not practice DELAYED START days because we do not have a DELAYED START policy.
- It costs approximately 78K a day to operate all schools.
- We also discussed how we handle warm weather day. Our schools are equipped with cooling stations throughout. A/C is available at: KES gym; KMS gym; each main office; KHS forum; all science rooms; wrestling room & hall; many KHS & KES classrooms; KMS not as many as windows make it difficult to install window units. Kirtland also has a few portable A/C units.
