Physical Education News from Mrs. G:

<u>Grades K,1, and 2</u> have been working on building their jump roping skills. Jump rope is a great way to exercise your heart! We have also been discussing the importance of daily exercise.

<u>Grades 2, 3, 4, 5</u> have all taken the Pacer Test; ask your child how they did! The Pacer test is a running test in which the students run a 20 meter lap at a certain pace. The pace increases with every level (about 7 laps). It is a great test of aerobic fitness as well as hard work.

Looking ahead: We will be rollerblading in grades 3, 4, and 5 starting the week of March 30 through April 24. All students will be required to bring in their own bike helmet to wear during this time. Rollerblades will be provided along with plenty of instruction.

SPRING 2020

JUST RUN of Lake County is a FREE running program for children that culminates at the JUST RUN 5k in Fairport Harbor on Saturday, May 23, 2020. If you're a JR veteran, welcome back. If you've heard of JUST RUN, join us! We practice at KES on weekday mornings before school. JUST RUN is open to any current 3^{rd} , 4^{th} or 5^{th} grade student. Students are dropped off by a parent at the atrium doors by 7:30am, supervised by coaches during running practice on the track, and then go to school at regular arrival time. Kindergarten, 1^{st} or 2^{nd} grade students are allowed to participate only if they are accompanied by their own parent to each practice session.

Running practices will be scheduled at KES during the following days at 7:30AM:

Week 1- Tuesday April 7 and Thursday April 9 We

Week 2- Tuesday April 14 and Friday April 17

Week 3- Tuesday April 21 and Friday April 24

Week 4- Tuesday April 28 and Friday May 1

Week 5- Tuesday May 5 and Thursday May 7

Week 6- Monday May 11 and Thursday May 14

Week 7- Tuesday May 19 and Thursday May 21

We combine running, stretching, games, races, and discussions about healthy lifestyles/race etiquette. We will practice in very light rain and hot/cold temps, just as on race day. In the event of seriously inclement weather (steady rain, snow on the track, below 20s wind-chill) we will stay indoors. If we need to cancel practice for any reason, we will email parents the night before school. Please ensure students have layers of athletic clothing and proper sneakers similar to a Physical Education day at school. New shoe orders are optional and available at a sale price at Second Sole Mentor from March 1- March 15th ONLY.

Online registration for our Kirtland JUST RUN team and 5k race in Fairport Harbor (one registration covers both) opens February 25 and continues through March 20. This time period includes the beginning of spring vacation so plan accordingly to register on time. Instructions are on the back of this sheet. Please pay careful attention to your shirt sizes. Once shirt sizes are ordered they cannot be changed. Since we practice in the mornings, choose any "after JR practice..." option in registration. Your child will simply stay at school for the day. Parents of K/1/2 students may register themselves as volunteers OR may sign a paper waiver at first practice to accompany your child during training. If you don't enter the race, your child will be responsible for racing on their own. Coaches and other adults are there to support your runner if you choose to watch the 5k.

JUST RUN alumni from prior years as well as parents of grade 3/4/5 students, spouses, grandparents, and neighbors who want to join on race day to support their student runner may practice at home and register for the Friends and Family 5k (same event, different name, different shirts to distinguish those K-5 students in JUST RUN). Unlike waiting in past years to register, Friends and Family 5k registration also opens right now and there is an early bird rate of \$15 until March 20. After that date, registration cost will be \$20 until May 18, and the final price is \$25 until day of race. We are looking forward to registering your child in the Kirtland Schools' Bright Beginnings Preschool for the upcoming school year! Many parents have already expressed their desire to have their child continue to attend the preschool housed at Kirtland Elementary School. We are very excited and pleased that your child has enjoyed the program this year and we look forward to your child continuing to grow in his/her academics in the year to come!

Registration: Kirtland resident registration opens on February 3, 2020 through April 24, 2020. Parents may register their child through the Kirtland Schools' website (http://www.kirtlandschools.org/) under the "Parent" tab in the "FinalForms" link. All paperwork must be completed to register your child.

Bright Beginnings Class Placement: To secure your child's placement in Bright Beginnings, parents must complete the registration packet in "FinalForms" and pay the \$100.00 deposit. Checks should be made payable to the Kirtland Local School District. Students will not be placed into a Bright Beginnings classroom until the FinalForms registration packet is completed and the deposit is paid. You may send the deposit to Diana Simpson at the Kirtland Board of Education.

Students must be 3 years old by September 1, 2020 and must be potty trained by the first day of school to attend Bright Beginnings.

Number of Classrooms: The number of Bright Beginnings' classes will depend upon student enrollment. Currently Bright Beginnings offers one class in the morning from 8:45-11:15. Our goal is to offer an afternoon class from 12:15-2:45; however the additional class will only be added if the number of students enrolled substantiates the additional classroom. A decision on the number of classes that will be offered will be made in April and parents will be notified by April 27, 2020 if their child has been placed in a Bright Beginnings Class.

Open House: Thursday, February 20, 2020 from 4:00-6:00 p.m. We welcome you and your child to meet the teacher while visiting the preschool classroom and learning about the curriculum, instruction and schedule.






