Mr. Dingeldein & Mr.Reynolds presented a slide show and handed out info regarding a request for the KHS Band to visit the Ohio University campus. Plans include: interacting with the band & attending an OU Wednesday night football game. Music boosters approved and already took care of transportation cost for the trip (nearly 8K). The band students pay the rest nearly \$75.00/pp (assistance available for anyone not able to cover cost).

CVA stated KLS has moved Prof Dev a couple of weeks into the school year–less chaos than at the beginning of year.

Wellness plans modeled with staff start with ADMIN. Safety drill in the afternoon went well. CVA & VP going to a Safety Conference this Friday.

Katy Nagy– @KES professional development day worked on PBIS & Standard Based Report Card work. Also working right now on Standards Based report card revision. “Flying a rocket ship as we build it.” Worked with ESC consultant for literacy and math. Circling back to math, we have been working on literacy for the past two years. Cognitively guided math instruction and inquiry based instruction. Looked at DATA: CRS (centralized reporting system), benchmarks, checkpoint data & how it will drive instruction. KES report cards will look a little different and they will communicate the changes to the parents/guardians. Will not have ABC grades except 5th graders (they just had them introduced last year so didnt want big change). Behavior grades will now align with the Hornet way (Humble, etc). No SCHOOL this FRI 9/22 for KES Prof Development.

Bob Race—@KMS started Prof Dev (PD) with Ike from ESC. Ike showed T's how to use CRS tool. Then jumped to the OST DATA analysis tool. Take every standard on OST (Ohio State Test) and then break down to see how specifically they can improve and can compare us to the state. Found our T's are performing very high (top 5%) across the state, a lot of areas performing above top 5%. Next session involved T's working on goals & PGP (Performance Growth Plan). T's look at how they intersect with not only S's but also with community and school. All T's now have their PGP's in. Afternoon PD sessions, Social Studies met with Ike from ESC dove into the date. SS really want a resource for SS, they lack having one. Looked at OST data, Ike from ESC said our SS scores are the highest scores he has seen in the area. They said for us to continue to keep doing what we are doing. SS Dept as a whole is doing phenomenal.

Jamie Smith (ELA) from ESC came in on Sept. 11 and observed our T's teaching to gain a better understanding of how they teach and their teaching styles.

Susan Huth (math) will also come in and observe T's to then come in and help guide T's in teaching skills.

Victor Puskas@ KHS. Staff wellness to start the day. Jen Berry led yoga class. Ike from ESC talked about the CRS (centralized reporting system). Take data and use to analyze where all S's are and compare to other S's, districts and other local schools. Bo Gladen came in and spoke with Science Teachers. Also worked with the new science teacher. T's worked on Prof Growth Plans (PGP's), all T's are done with plans. Worked with MTS coordinator to work with students. She has a schedule works with S's everyday, and will help S's that need to pass tests & competency. Also had safety drills.

ODE now becoming: Department of Education and Workforce. Divided into three parts now: 1. SBOE (license). 2.) Dept of Ed Workforce 3.) Department of Children and Youth

Additional update from CVA (Sept. 29, 2023) since meeting:

- Update on my SLA presentation on HB 33-The Franklin County Court of Common Pleas has issued a temporary restraining order (“TRO”) blocking Governor DeWine and other

state agents from implementing the provisions of Ohio House Bill 33 (“HB 33”) that create the Department of Education and Workforce (“DEW”) and strip the State Board of Education of many of its powers. Under the provisions of HB 33, the Ohio Department of Education would be reorganized into the DEW.

Third Grade Reading Guarantee and Literacy: Maintains the THIRD GRADE READING GUARANTEE and its retention requirement, but provides an exemption from retention if: 1.) if the S’s parent, in consultation w/ reading T & principal, requests that the S be promoted, and (2) the S continues to receive reading intervention services until they read at grade level.

Pupil Transportation if not compliant our district can be penalized for non compliance.
