## No Red Ink and CommonLit Overview (SA)

NRI and CommonLit provide reading comprehension and support help. It's a very valuable resource for teachers and students. Acts as a supplement for reading comprehension. Program is multi-tiered: works through all grades (adjusts according to each reader's reading level); ?'s all related & standards based; actionable so can be utilized in the classroom; relates to all content areas. We are onboarding **CommonLit 360** on July 1st, using grades 6-12. This is used in addition to the textbooks they are reading. **No Red Ink** is similar to CL but as a writing platform. Supplementing what is already taught when it comes to writing. No Red Ink highlights: Pathways called playlists (curtail to each S); can target specific areas; real time data; adaptive as writing; there are free writes teachers give prompts & S's write on the prompt; can connect the writing to something they are reading.
