ESC of Western Reserve presentation by Jeremy Hunter. Two components of this fully online platform: Schools PLP for grades K-12, which offers 550 courses of core courses, credit recovery, career pathways, and Honors or Ap courses. All aligning with state and national standards. Edmentum focuses on grades 6-12, the goal is to make personalized learning a greater possibility in the classroom. The courses are self-paced, monitored and provide tutorial support.

Return to previous school schedule seen in 2019-2020 school year with home base, hybrid of block scheduling and late starts with Professional Development in the high school, 8:30-3:30 times in the elementary school. There will not be delayed starts as in the past year as a result of bus cleaning.

COVID-19 restrictions have been lifted following Lake County Health Departments.

Professional Development with continue work of "Profile of a Hornet." Received \$20,000 from the Martha Holden Jennings. There is a curricular review of English Language Arts with focus on writing, phonics, and strengthening the reading piece this year.

The Junior and Senior experience was discussed by Mr. Scott Amstutz. Senior Project and Junior Internship was modified in house due to COVID-19. Seniors spent their Service Day providing help in six different areas within the community.

The Seniors experienced a frigid day at Red Oak Camp and opted for to go bowling with staff members. The last day was graduation practice.

Juniors spent two days listening to different speakers and practicing their interviewing skills with multiple mock interviews. They also received a piece on financing for colleges, and information was given on SCORE with an online hub to provide resources for survival for small businesses.
