- The district needs to plan for a cost of \$875,000 to replace the scoreboard and turf in TEN years in a worst case scenario.
  - The district will have an estimated \$215,000 to put toward the replacement cost
  - \$875,000 (ten yr. Replacement cost) \$215,000 (sponsorship/naming rights)=
    \$660,000 needed
- The district needs to plan for a cost of \$875,000 to replace the scoreboard and turf in 14 years years in a best case scenario.
  - The district will have (\$215,000 + \$80,000 naming rights + \$250,000 scoreboard)
    \$545,000 to cover the \$875,000= \$330,000 needed
- The district needs to plan for a cost of \$875,000 to replace the scoreboard and turf in 12 years years in a "somewhere in the middle" scenario.
  - The district will have (\$215,000 + \$40,000 naming rights + \$80,000 scoreboard)
    \$335,000 to cover the \$875,000= \$540,000 needed

Recommendedion is to but \$45,000 a year from the general fund into a saparate account to here \$540,000 available to the scoreboard and turif replacement in 12 years.
