
On the horizon for GIFTED spring 2022....

- Take a deeper look at ways to start compacting math for a specific set of students starting in Grade 5 (instead of in Grade 7)


IXL- Diagnostic and Online Curriculum (slide presentation SA)

Scott Amstutz gave a presentation on how IXL (like excel, play on words IXL) is utilized in ELA, Math, and Science. Piloted primarily in MS. Diagnostic for assessment and online going to use to help close gaps with targeted instruction and also offers standards based support. Enhance gifted learning with content. Falls under our pillar of Personalized Learning.
