### **ELA Pilot and Update:**

ELA our buildings have heard from multiple companies and reps. T's have worked with them to narrow it down. Literacy Committee: saw four vendors, of the four vendors one had what KES was looking for, K-3 currently also teaches Foundations, this year they adopted the Haggerty program & saw the need for something that is comprehensive. "CKLA Amplified" is the only program that fits best. K & 1st have already started using some of the resources to teach it. 4-5th not as honed in on phonemic awareness, focus more on teaching explicit vocabulary. HMH and CKLA were front runners, CKLA (Core Knowledge Language Arts).

David Leone 6-8th grade ELA has narrowed us down to four companies. MS T's drawn more to CKLA Amplified: great support, great structure, voice and choice, allowed for differentiation. If it does what they think it will do they think it will make a big difference.

KHS: Looking at our current resources, pausing on any pilot until the end of 2nd semester.
