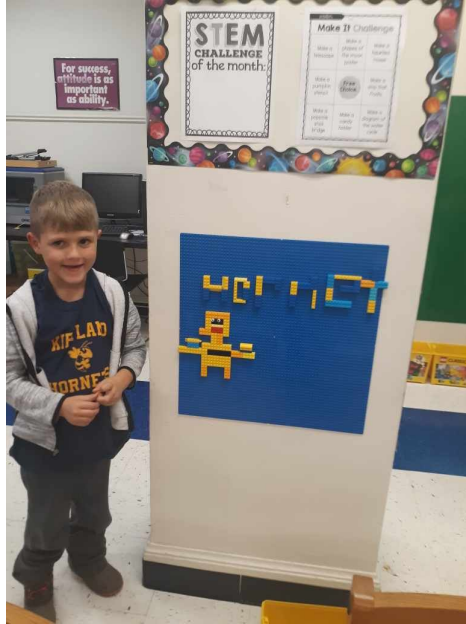


## KES STEAM News and Notes (Nov/Dec 2019)
