





- Do not include any opinions

#### Retell

- Tell the story again
- · Use the author's words
- Add as many details as possible

#### Summarize


- Tell only the most important events from the story
- Put events in your own words
- Keep in mind the BIG IDEAwhat the story is mostly about




- only use details from the text
- Keep the details in the correct order








