This spring has certainly thrown us all a curve ball! While we were not able to finish out the school year as we had planned, the Kirtland PTA worked hard for the families of Kirtland throughout the 2019-2020 academic year.

This year, the Kirtland PTA sponsored many events to benefit the students and families of the Kirtland School District. Some of these activities included: the KES Ice Cream Social, classroom Halloween parties, Candidates' Night, Deck the Halls, PTA Reflections, Heart Healthy Day, Family BINGO Night, Princess Prom, and Boys' Bowling Bash. We awarded scholarships to three deserving KHS seniors and made a donation to the KHS After Prom. At KMS, we purchased locks for all incoming 6th grade students, sponsored the KMS dances throughout the year, and helped to create a new alternate rec space called the Hornet Hangout. We are proud to be able to serve all the students in our district.

The Kirtland PTA also offered new opportunities for family engagement. Our PTA Speaker Series included: "Interpreting State Report Card Data" led by experts from the Ohio PTA, "A View from the Bench" with Willoughby Municipal Court Judge Marisa L. Cornachio, "Protecting Your Children from Online Predators" with Magistrate Holly Welsh, and "Family Fun Yoga" led by Chris Keller from Circle of Renewal Yoga and Wellness Studio.

We also began a new program called Hornet Heroes to recognize Kirtland teachers and staff members (by community nominations) who go above and beyond for our students each month.

Despite our inability to be together over the last several months, the Kirtland PTA continues to be a resource for our families.
